# Investments opportunities to grow youth and women owned agribusiness

- Aceli Africa is a donor funded organization with a mandate to bridge the gap between the supply and demand for capital in the agri-sector in KE, RW, UG and TZ.
- Aceli focus areas: (1) Financial incentives to lenders (2) Technical assistance to SMEs (3) Data & learning

#### 1. Financial Incentives

- <u>First loss cover</u> to increase lender risk appetite; <u>Origination incentive</u> to increase return to lenders to compensate for additional costs of underwriting and managing small agri-loans
- 18 lenders accredited since September 2020 (commercial banks, social lenders, NBFIs).
  - The social lenders are more driven by impact rather than financial returns and are potential sources of funding, especially for women and youth led enterprises.
- Additional incentive (impact bonuses) which reward lenders for lending to high impact businesses.
  - Aim is to catalyze incremental lending to high impact SMEs (gender inclusive, climate smart and contribute to food security) Aligns to PABRA's work
  - Youth is an impact area that we are yet to include in our financial incentives, but are strongly considering.

### 2. Technical Assistance

- TA support to agri-SMEs is also critical to solve the access to finance puzzle.
- Through our TA programs, we set out to build the capacity of SMEs to develop viable, sustainable business models and practices to be able to access and deploy finance. Ultimately, there is no lender/ investor who will walk away from a good deal. Our TA is designed to help SMEs present the best deal possible.
- In line with our impact agenda, we are especially keen on working with youth and women-owned businesses to enhance their access to finance.
